What is Class II Gaming Today?

Class II gaming describes a category of games that use bingo mechanics as the method to determine outcomes -- even if the game looks like a traditional commercial casino game usually driven by a random number generator (RNG).

What is Bingo Game Logic

Bingo game logic is an alternative to RNG based outcome generation, where systems like central server determines game outcomes using a virtual bingo card that is filled in by the system and complete specific patterns which determine a win.

In today's Class II games, this usually happens in the background, and the virtual bingo card result is displayed as a traditional slot game, displaying a winning or losing combination of reels.

It's important to understand that what the actual display looks like is extremely flexible, and could be be made to look like any traditional or exotic, new casino game.

What is Class II Mobile On-Premise Gaming?

Class II mobile on-premise gaming describes people playing Class II games over Wi-Fi or other secure network within the physical boundaries of a casino.

Accessing these Class II games, which look and feel like some of the industry's most beloved casino games, is incredibly convenient for players, and gamblers are strongly adopting them.

All of this is enabled by technology that ensures that the gameplay is secure and complies with laws and regulations. This technology is being deployed widely by leading first movers in this category, like the Chickasaw Nation's WinStar World Casino and Resort in Oklahoma.
